School Hampers and Student Sponsorship for Needy Children

Facilitating Education Opportunities for Poor Students

The Guyana Islamic Trust has begun serving approximately 130 poor students with school supplies, daily hot meals and transportation allowances to school. These students, rated as most deserving cases, reside in the Sophia and Buxton areas respectively. This project is very critical; since it is only by empowering students through education can these children and their families be lifted out of poverty.

PROJECT SUMMARY

The School Project consists of three components: Providing school hampers consisting of uniforms, socks and shoes, under clothes, school bags/ lunch kits and stationery to very deserving students; providing at least one nutritious hot meal for students whose parents are unable to provide one meal a day for them and paying the cost for transportation and a small allowance for needy Secondary students who are attending schools outside of their community.
